Accra, Ghana — Women Empowered International is convening a groundbreaking gathering of young women leaders from the United States, Sierra Leone, and Ghana for the Young Women Empowered Summit, taking place September 14-16, 2025 in Accra. This powerful event will bring together emerging change-makers to explore leadership, economic growth, and the future of African and diaspora communities.
